CHAUTAUQUA – Mahtomedi History!

Streetcar Park, S to Neptune, to Pine, Quail, Park, Spruce, Tamarack and return to park. 1.0 miles

See: Chautauqua Sites; Harmon and Helmes Cabins; Lake Accesses; Flink's Log Home; Chautauqua Hotel; Hamline Lake

LIFE'S A BEACH – Early Settlement. Hickory and Park, N to Locust, E on Maple, S on Summit, E to Arbor, S to Hickory, W to Park; 1.1 miles

See: White Bear Lake; Beach; early Mahtomedi neighborhoods

BACK TO SCHOOL – featuring site of 1932 school – the DEC. Maple and Streetcar Trail to Streetcar Park; E on Burlington Northern Trail to Griffin; S to Heidi; W to Warner; S to Maple; W to start. 1.2 miles

See: Hamline Lake; Depot Lake; Burlington Trail

FOREST HEIGHTS – From The Streetcars to the Lake.

Hickory and 244; E and then S behind Coventry to St. Jude's; S on Streetcar Trl to Roma; W to Triangle; Cross to Ash; W to Park; N to Hickory; E to 244. 1.45 miles.

See: Streetcar Trail; Forest Heights; Lake

AMUSING! Wildwood Park; N to 244; Cross to Wildwood Beach Rd (or stay on trail); N to Ash; cross to Triangle Park; S to Gordy's; W to Derby; S to Stewart; R to Wildwood; S to Milford; R to Kimberly; L to Chatham; R to Robert; R to Park. 1.5 miles

See: Wildwood Park; Streetcar Trail; WW Amusement Park; Willemie's small streets – home of carnival barkers!

KEN WOOD IF WILL WOOD: Burlington Trail and Harmony; N to Wildwood Bay and around that; N to Kenwood; W to landing and return; E on Williams Woods to end and return to Hallam; S to Burlington Trail; W to start. 1.7 miles.

See: Depot Lake; North Long Lake; woods

THREE TRAILS/ TWO PATHS: St. Jude's parking lot; N behind Coventry; E Hickory; N Warner; E Iris; N Griffin; E Juniper; S footpath opposite Hallam; S Hallam Court; S Eastgate Trail; W Dahlia; N on path to Gosiwin; W Gosiwin Ct. to Trail; W to Warner; S to Dahlia; W to trail; return on trail to St. Jude's. 2 miles.

See: ponds and nature; small streets; Streetcar Trail and woods; Silver Slipper speakeasy, Elsie Inn

ANDY'S AMBLE: This walk

does not yet exist! It's an exercise/nature loop for St. A Village. N end Village parking lot; E and S around building; cross bridge into the woods; up Wharton Trail to water tower; Tower Road to St. A Church; driveway and path to Dahlia and East; N on Eastgate Trail to Hickory; E to Village. 1.0 miles.

See: lovely woods; interesting trails; your water tower!

BOOKS AND AUTHORS: Library; W to GlenMar; S to 72nd; W to Warner; N to Warwick; W to Paddington; N to Sargent; E to Penway; N to Stillwater Rd; E to Library. 1.4 miles.

See: Willemie, home of our old library (Domino's) and of two published authors – one of them the mayor!

O.H. WHAT A FEELING! O.H. Anderson parking lot; E through playground to NE corner; cut through woods to 72nd Ct; Homewood to Hallam Ave, to Hallam Curve to Hallam Ave.; N to Huron; W to Glenmar; S to 72nd; W to Warner; S to O.H. 1.8 miles.

See: O.H. Anderson's great nature trail – thanks Julie Henriksson!

OLD FOLKS GET WILD! K. Abbott Park; S to Wildridge; W to Woodland; n on sidewalk at cul de sac to Arcwood; N to Old Wildwood Rd; E on trail to Streetcar Trail; S to K. Abbott. 1.65 miles.

See: Echo Lake, wooded streets; beautiful trail

HEAR AN ECHO? Woodland Rd entrance to Echo Shores Park; through park to peninsula; out to end and return; S to Century College; uphill to Wedgewood cul de sac; Wedgewood (Echo Lake Blvd if you like) to Woodland; E to start. 1.1 miles.

See: Echo Shores Park, maybe our most beautiful

THE JAMES GANG: Wedgewood and Shamrock; N to Jesse James; to Wedgewood; N to Oakridge; S to Shamrock; W to park entrance; through park around the pond; back to Shamrock; E to Wedgewood. 1.5 miles.

See: Beautiful, complete, Wedgewood Park

MARCHING IN MOCASSINS: Streetcar Park; W on Briarwood to Hazel; N to Mocassin; W to Dwinell; R to Quail; S to Laurel; S to Quail; S to Streetcar Park. 1.35 miles.

See: streets in the woods; Depot Lake; Streetcar Park

PINING FOR A STROLL? Pine Tree Hills. Shady Woods and Overlook; NE to Glen Edge; S to Many Levels W to start. 1.5 m

See: Tree-lined streets and neighborhood; Depot Lake

PINES AND PARK: K Abbott parking lot; E on grass to Bichner; E to Warner; S to Pinehurst; W to end and Long Lake Rd; E to trail (park or Streetcar); N to beginning. 1.7 miles

See: Pine Springs, one of the beautiful villages of western Washington County; trails in K. Abbott

WALKING TO COLLEGE: Ledgestone and Long Lake Rd; N on sidewalk to campus; across Campus to NE corner; Echo Shores Park Trail to Woodland; E to Wildridge; E to Pineview Ct; S to sidewalk to Dunbar; W to Echo Park sidewalk; trail to Kilbemie; W to Dunbar; S to Long Lake Rd; W to Ledgestone. 2.2 miles.

See: Hidden Century College; loop around Echo Lake

CANOE WALK WITH ME? N. on Berwick from Long Lake Rd to Kilbemie; W to Dunbar; N to Canoe Rack; return to Warwick; E to trail; N through Echo Park; E on Dunbar to Pineview Ct. to Wildridge; E to Lincoln town; N to K Abbott; park trail S to Long Lake; E to Berwick. 2.2 miles.

See: Canoe launch on Echo Lake; Echo Park; Katherine Abbott; South Long Lake

BIRCHWOOD 8: City Hall, E Birchwood; R Birch St and Path; L Wildwood; R Ash Walkway; L Birchwood; tennis court trail; R Cedar; L Oakridge; L Five Oaks; R Birchwood; Norling Park; White Pine to Hall; Grotto Walkway to Tighe Schmitz Park; R to Lake Ave; L to Wildwood; R to Cedar; R Birchwood to City Hall. 1.9 miles.
